Removing it will allow more light and growth to the surrounding trees and hedge. This tree in our opinion is not TPO worthy and its removal will not affect the integrity of the local landscape. | 3 Prebendal Close Nassington
- [20/01608/TPO/](#) | T1 Maple (Crimson King) - Remove lowest small branch (about 15 to 20cm diameter) at 1 metre high, back to the trunk; reduce branches facing house by 0.5 to 1 metre; reduce branches over road by 1 to 2 metres; reduce lower branch on the south side of the tree (15cm diameter) by 1 to 2 metres to shape. | 1 Prebendal Close Nassington
